We are hoping to introduce a **baptism preparation programme** for the parish.

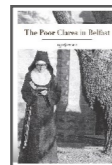
In order to do this we need a few volunteers to help with 'drop-in' visits in the homes of the new babies - just a friendly face and an encouraging word to the young couple.
